The Bristol-Myers Squibb Patient Assistance Foundation, Inc. is a non-profit organization that was established in 1998 to provide temporary assistance to qualifying patients with a financial hardship. The program provides assistance for certain medications to indigent patients in all 50 states.

▶ **Who may be eligible for assistance?**

The program provides assistance to qualifying patients who have an established financial hardship, and who are U.S. Citizens or Legal Residents.

▶ **How do patients apply?**

All qualifying patients and their healthcare providers must complete a program application to be considered for assistance. This application may be obtained by contacting us at **1•800•736•0003**. A printable version is also available at **[www.bmspaf.org](http://www.bmspaf.org)**. Completed applications may be submitted by either fax or mail.

▶ **What information is needed to apply?**

Applicants are required to provide information regarding household income, prescription insurance coverage, and citizenship, along with both the patient and healthcare provider signatures.
